TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION THROUGH RECIPROCITY

The Surveyors Boards of the Australian States and Territories and New Zealand, have had reciprocal arrangements in place since 1892.

Registered/Licensed Surveyors whom are authorised to undertake land/boundary/cadastral surveys can apply for registration with another Board, by obtaining a Letter of Accreditation from their Board of first registration.

Other registered persons can apply for transfers to another Board, provided the second Board offers/has available an equivalent registration status to that available from the first Board, e.g. for Mine Surveyors.

Applications for a Letter of Accreditation must be made by completing the following questionnaire in the form of a Statutory Declaration. You should also check with your first Board of registration what fee may have to be paid for the Letter of Accreditation.

Having applied for the Letter of Accreditation, contact the Board where you wish to become registered and request their application form(s) and the registration fees payable. Contact phone numbers are on this site.

Applicants should note that the following questionnaire (Statutory Declaration) is the Queensland format.

You will need to change the wording on the areas *highlighted* to meet the statutory declaration requirements in your own State/Territory.
